Goals and objectives: The Faculty Support Research Initiative is a competitive based program designed to give research faculty the support they need to produce research proposals and major scholarly works (i.e. book project), and to increase the involvement of students in research encouraging them to pursue graduate-level research and study.

Funding: Awards of up to \$2,500 per student per year will be made to COHPA researchers to provide support for research student wages.

Application Procedure:

- 1. Completely fill out the Faculty Sponsored Research Support Initiative Form.
- 2. Submit application form electronically by email.
- 3. Department chairs will review applications and submit recommendations to the Dean.
- 4. The Dean will review Chair recommendations and select final applications for approval
- 5. Hire the student on the department account. Provide the COHPA Office of Research with a copy of the EPAF for the student with your account number for the student's wages. The COHPA Office of Research will transfer the student's cost each semester from your account to a COHPA Office of Research account.
